We recently received a letter from him, in which he talks about some of the different types of education and training he and his community have received. He goes on to say that in the future he would like to be a carpenter and build his own house. There was also a note attached thanking us for the wealth of postcards and letters he received last year; he mentions that he has read them many times!

Due to the extraordinary circumstances we find ourselves in this year, it is not going to be possible for the current Year 5s to complete the project. However, after showing his letter to a couple of the bubbles working in school, some children have expressed an interest in trying to gain sponsorship again to help support him. This is, of course, optional and please be aware that Wah Pree will still receive the annual level of funding from school.

If this is something you would be interested in, I have attached a sponsorship form including some ideas for sponsored events, or if you would like to keep it less formal than this then feel free! Any contributions towards his sponsorship will be paid to ActionAid and sent directly to his immediate community as a community grant. In the past this has been used to buy educational materials, clothing, play equipment and much more.
