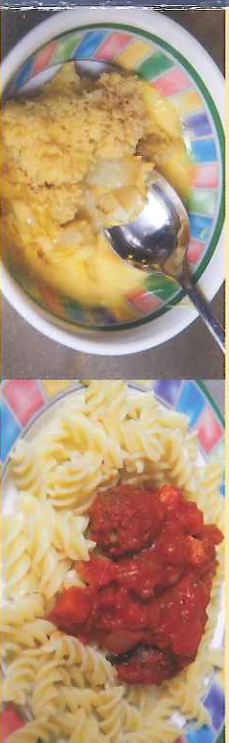
William Farr School has been providing hot school meals to primary schools in the local area since 2008.



We provide a two course meal every lunch time, plus a piece of wholemeal bread and some fresh fruit for each child.

Most of the meals are home cooked in the William Farr catering department using fresh local ingredients, by a team of professionally trained staff.

The Kitchen has been awarded 5 stars by the West Lindsey environmental health department, and all staff are trained to CIEH level 2 in food hygiene or higher.



We try to provide a varied menu which will introduce the children to a range of different foods.

All the menus comply with the government food based standards.

Our aim is to use as many local ingredients and food supply companies as possible:

- Fresh bread from Market Rasen.
- Fresh milk and cream from a dairy at Newark.
- Beef, Pork and Lamb from local farm assured farms and butchered in Lincoln.
- Diced chicken from Norfolk with Red Tractor accreditation.
- Fresh vegetables and fruit from local suppliers in the Lincoln area.
- Frozen food from Nottingham. Any frozen vegetables are Red Tractor accredited.
- Organic meatballs from a farm in Derbyshire.
- Most of the fish used is responsibly sourced.

Our menus are also **Bronze Food for Life** accredited, among other criteria, this means that:

- Food on our menu does not contain any undesirable additives, transfats or GM ingredients.
- At least 75% of the dishes on our menu are freshly prepared.
- All meat is from farms which satisfy UK welfare standards.
- We use free range eggs.
- Our menus cater well for dietary needs in the school population.
