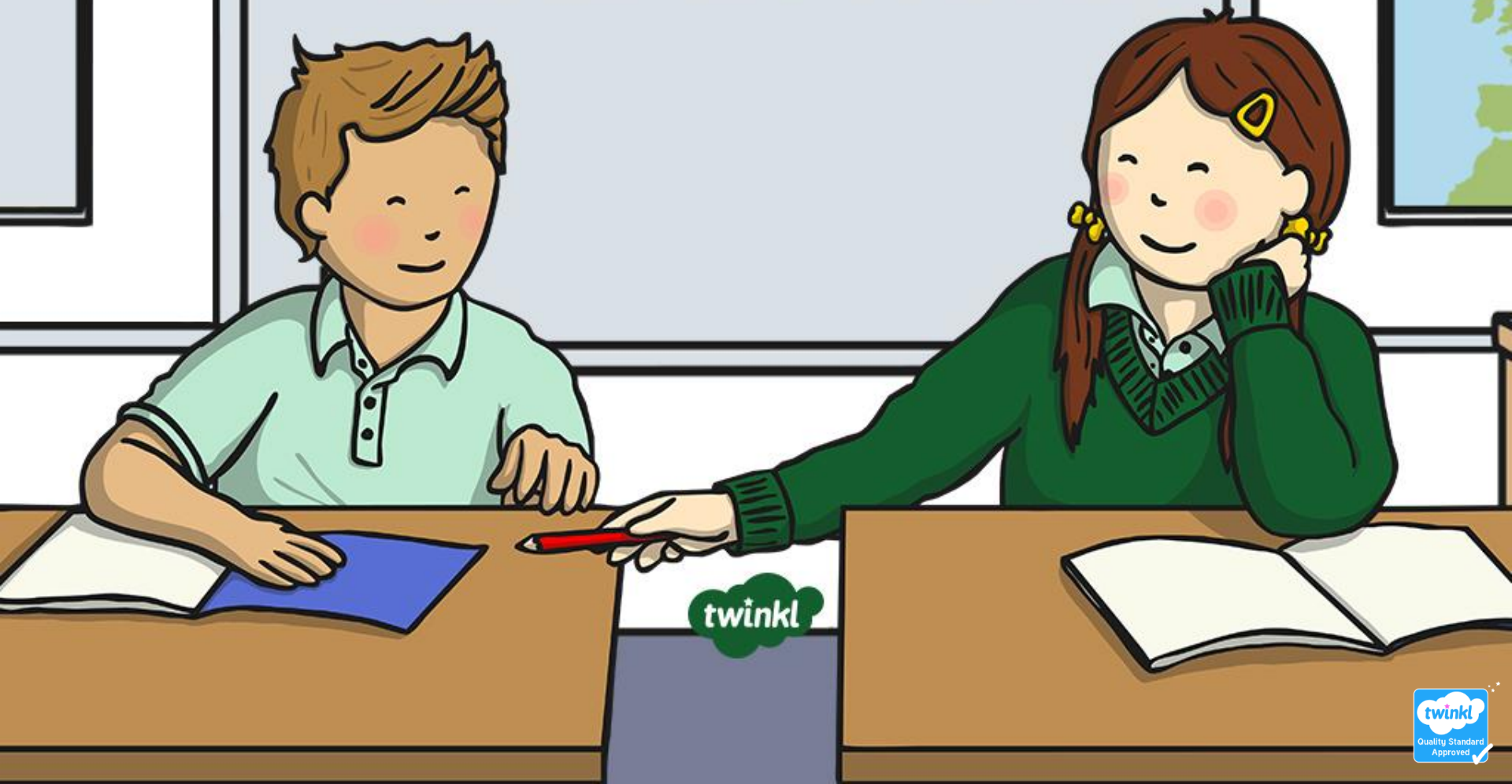

Instructions are written for someone who needs to know how to do something.



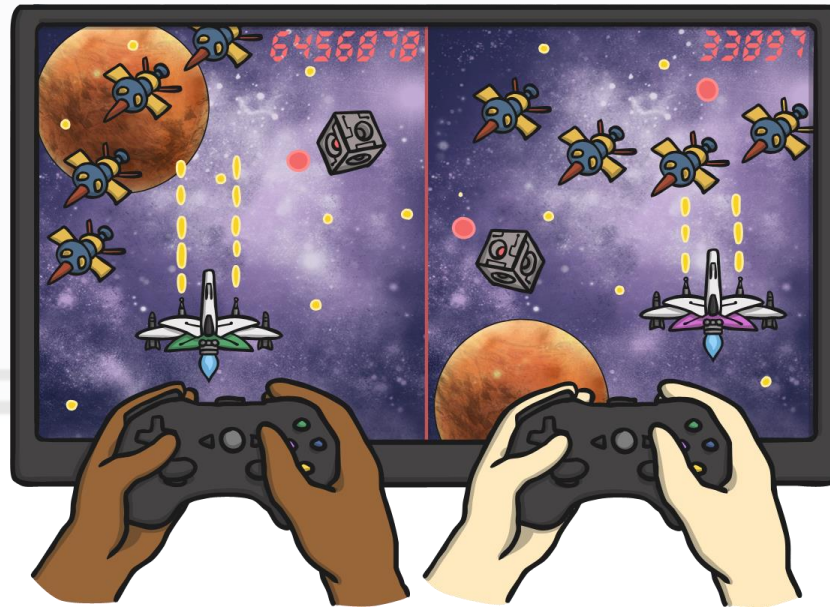

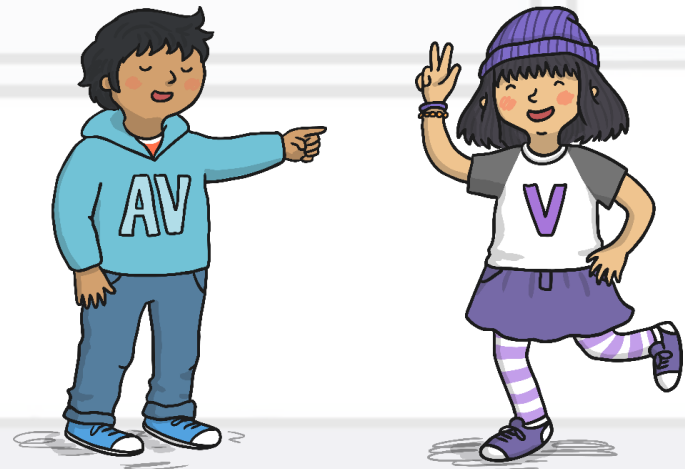

How to Write Instructions

1. Write in the present tense.
2. Use imperative verbs and adverbs to begin each step.
3. Use numbers to sequence the steps/instructions.
4. Use topic words.
5. Create clear and concise simple sentences.



How To Plant A Sunflower Seed

What you need:

- A small pot
- Soil
- Seeds
- Watering can
- Water



What you do:

1. Fill the pot with soil to just below the top.
2. Add a little water to the soil.
3. Gently press one or two seeds into the soil.
4. Cover the seeds with a small amount of soil.
5. Carefully pour more water onto the soil.



Top Tip:

Water the soil everyday to help your sunflower grow.

How To Make Fruit Pizzas

You will need:

- 4 Digestive biscuits
- Natural yoghurt
- 3 – 4 different types of fruit
e.g. apple, banana, grapes, orange
- Plate
- Spreading knife
- Sharp knife
- A grown up

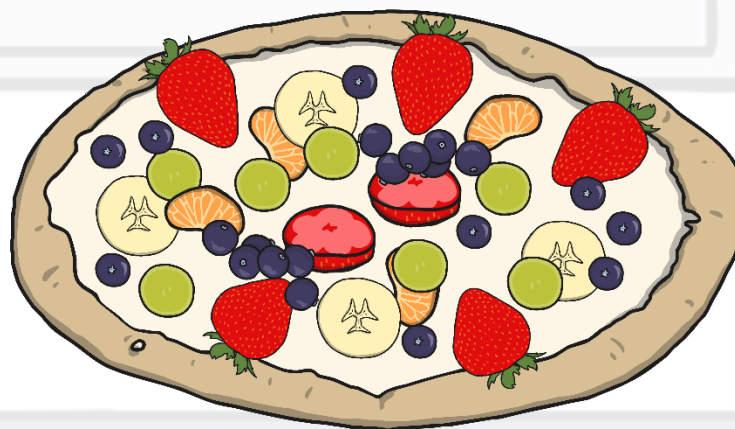
What to do:

1. Place 4 biscuits on the plate.
2. Evenly spread the yoghurt onto each biscuit.
3. Cautiously cut up the fruit into small pieces. (Ask a grown up to help you when using the sharp knife.)
4. Put the fruit on top of the yoghurt.
