A Yummy way to learn about circumference
(Please feel free to use any other round biscuit!)

What is circumference?

Step #1: Wrap String around your Oreo (or digestive, or jaffa cake?!)

Step #2: Use a ruler to measure the length of the string. This is the circumference of your biscuit.

Step #3: Record your findings.

Now find four other circular objects and repeat steps #1-#3

**** To measure a circle's diameter, you must go through the CENTRE point of the circle. ****
