Nouns give a name to things: table, weather, people, rings.

Adjectives describe those nouns: pretty flowers, noisy hounds.

Verbs tell you what we do: bounce, swim, think and chew.

Adverbs tell you how it's done: slowly, loudly, or just for fun.

Preposition? It's in the name: under, over again and again.

Replacing nouns is **pronoun**'s thing: he, she, it, they, her and him.

Conjunctions are there to stick, clauses together like cement and brick.
