Please send your produce into school, ideally on Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup>, Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> and Friday 24<sup>th</sup> of September.

In terms of what could be donated, Lincoln Community Larder are currently issuing the following guidance, we hope that it helps plan your harvest box:

"Tins of: Fruit, Rice Pudding, Tuna, Meats – (eg stews, meatballs, curries), Hot Dogs, Peas, Carrots, Sweetcorn, Tomatoes. 'Weetabix' or own brand equivalent, Other breakfast cereals, Instant Coffee (small jars), Sugar (250g packs), Jam, Marmalade or Lemon Curd, Pasta sauces. Semi-skimmed UHT milk. Instant Mashed Potato, Biscuits, Puddings, Jellies, 'Angel Delight'.
