


RULES FOR SAFE USE OF THE INTERNET



Improving the way we communicate with you

As a school we always try to ensure that our communications with you are as clear, timely and helpful as possible. Effective communications to and from parents are at the heart of the school community we are building.

In order to improve our communications with you further, we are introducing a new service called TXTRound that enables us to communicate with you using text messages (SMS) to your mobile phone or land line. This will enable us to you to receive short reminders of important events, and other information wherever and whenever you happen to be. The system is also capable of sending newsletters via email in the future.

This approach has been used in many schools and has been found to be very helpful for both parents and school staff.

Finally, we hope that you find this approach helpful. We welcome your feedback and comments. Rest assured your personal information is always are fully covered under Data Protection rules.



Sign up for free school meals now!

Dear Parent/Guardian

From September, all pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 will be able to receive a school meal at no cost to the parent/guardian as recently announced by the Government. School meals are healthy, tasty, social and fun and from September 2014 choosing a school lunch for your child/children will help save you up to £450 per year if you take up the offer. A school lunch will also provide a varied and balanced diet and provide the right amount of energy to ensure that your child can work better in the afternoons.

From September there will be a new universal eligibility checking service for free school meals, which will enable us to check all primary and secondary school pupils for free school meal eligibility. This system will also determine eligibility for Pupil Premium, which means schools will receive an extra £1,300 per eligible pupil from central government to fund valuable support such as extra tuition and learning support.


To help ensure that we are able to claim the correct level of funding, please provide the details requested on the form overleaf and return it to school as soon as possible. Parents do not have to provide this information but we would encourage you to register so that we receive as much Pupil Premium funding as possible.

To avoid requesting this information again, Lincolnshire County Council will store your data securely and it will be checked periodically for eligibility.

For more information on school menus, please contact us for a copy. Meat and vegetarian options are available every day and most dietary requirements can be catered for.



IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT ORDERING AND PAYING FOR HOT SCHOOL MEALS AND TRIPS

We are excited to announce a new service for ordering and paying for Hot School Meals and trips.

sQuid eMoney is already used, very successfully, at William Farr School for their cashless catering. We think that our new service will give you more control over when and how to order and pay for meals and trips. Although our children are very good at bringing your money to school, this is safer and you can see exactly what you have paid and can access the service at your convenience.

One you have registered, you will be able to order meals for the term. You will get further information and your registration details in June.

You will be able to order for just one week or for up to five weeks in advance. You can also choose to vary the days each week. As before, you will be able to choose the vegetarian option to suit your child's dietary needs. Orders need to be placed at least one school week in advance.

We have thought long and hard about the best way to implement the new system and, following discussions with parents and looking at the experience of other schools, we decided to go onto a fully electronic ordering and payment system for meals without 'halfway house' arrangements i.e. there will be no cash/cheque payment option. If your child is entitled to free school meals you will need to register and order in the same way, but no payment will be requested.


Payment for trips will also be available via sQuid immediately alongside the more traditional methods of payment. We are sure you will find this service easy to use and very flexible.

To make it easier to buy the school uniform, we have chosen to use the Parents Online ordering service from Price & Buckland.

You can either choose to have delivery made to school, which is free of charge and done on a monthly basis, or you can have delivery made within 5 working days to a personal address for a charge of £2.50.

We must make you aware that the price of uniforms will rise slightly as a result of using this service. Up until this point school has sold uniform at 'cost' price with no additional fee for administration.


