Biography Extension Task

Your challenge is to create a mini documentary.

This can be based on the biography you have already written or it could be about someone new. You may even enjoy finding out about someone in your family by interviewing them and then using this information to create a documentary about them.

You need to include all the information you would for a written biography (see planning resources on our school website).

Your documentary could take the form of a short video, or a series of short videos about different aspects of their life. If you have iMovie, or equivalent, you could turn these short videos into a documentary movie. If you don't have access to an iPad, tablet or similar you could record your voice as if your documentary is on the radio. You could take photos or find images and compile them into a presentation using PowerPoint or similar. You could even act it out or do it as a chat show style interview and record this.

We appreciate you may not have video editing software; these are just some ideas about how you could complete the challenge. You can be as creative as you want to be with the resources you have.

Make it fun, entertaining and full of facts. Remember, you should want to watch it yourself.
