

Milk Bottle Top Elephant Art Challenge

This week we would like you to create a milk bottle top elephant. Mr Spowage had a go at this last week with his children and documented the process he followed in the pictures on the right. You might want to follow these same steps, or you might choose to decorate yours in a different way; have a look at the other photos at the bottom of this sheet.

Caution – You will require adult supervision and help at some points during this project: be careful when using scissors; take care if using hot glue guns or strong types of glue; don't make too much mess!
