

# PRIME NUMBERS

Prime numbers are numbers (greater than 1) that cannot be divided by any number except themselves and one.

The numbers shown in yellow are all prime numbers.  
1 is not a prime number!

To test if a number is a prime, divide it by 2, 3, 5, 7, 9 or 11.
